

SIGNIFICANT DOCTRINAL TRUTHS IN ROMANS 3:19-26)

LAW --

- Mosaic
- Moral
- Pentateuch

RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD – the Gospel reveals the Righteousness of God (Rom.1:16,17)

IMPUTATION – to put to the account of another (Philemon 18; Hebrews 7:4-10)

- Adam's sin to all mankind (Rom.3:23; 5:12-21)
- Man's sin to Christ (Isaiah 53:5,6; 1 Peter 2:24; 2 Corinthians 5:21)
- God's righteousness to believers (Rom.3:22; 5:15-19; 2 Corinthians 5:21)

SIN – “Anything in man which does not express, or which is contrary to, the character of our holy God”

- Personal (Romans – chapters 1 & 2)
- Transmitted sin nature (Psalm 51:5; John 3:6; Ephesians 4:17-22)
- Imputed sin (Rom.5:13; 1 Cor.15:22; Phile.18; Heb.7:4-10)

REDEMPTION –

- Agoradzo – to buy or purchase in the marketplace (1 Cor.6:20; 7:23; 2 Pet.2:1; Rev.5:9; 14:3)
- Exagoradzo – to buy or purchase out of the marketplace for one's self (Gal.3:13; 4:5; Col.4:5)
- Lutroo – to redeem, liberate on receipt of a ransom (1 Pet.1:18; Tit.2:14)
- Apolutrosis – liberation – released – through payment of a ransom – SET FREE!! HALLELUJAH!!! (Rom.3:24; 8:23; Eph.1:7; Col.1:14; Heb.9:15)

JUSTIFICATION – to be declared righteous by God

- Justified by God – God is the source of the imputation of righteousness - (Rom.3:26,30; 8:30,33)
- Justified in Christ's blood – which is the ground of justification (Rom.3:25; 5:9)
- Justified by faith – the means of justification (Rom.3:22; 4:5; 5:1)
- Justified by works -- which is the evidence of justification (Rom.4:2; James 2:14-26)
- Justified in Him – as the result (2 Cor.5:21)
- Justified on account of the resurrection – which is the seal of our righteousness (Ro.4:25)
- Justified by grace – which is the essence of justification (Rom.3:24; Tit.3:7)
- Justified by the Spirit – which is the sphere of justification (1 Cor.6:11)
